"He's a horse that's trained very well all winter and in company with some very good horses that have gone on to be successful," four-time Wood Memorial-winning trainer Todd Pletcher said. "So, we've been a little frustrated with his races this year. We're excited to get him back to Aqueduct. It's where he broke his maiden and stretching out to a mile and an eighth is going to allow him to show his true ability."

With 170 total qualifying points for the GI Kentucky Derby up for grabs, the Wood is worth 100 points to the winner, 40 points to second, 20 to third and 10 to fourth.
